## PUERTO RICO

### What to Bring List

We are so excited to host you! We are limited in space in the vehicles. To ensure enough room for everyone and their items and due to limited space in vehicles, **please pack at the most 2 items per person: one (1) suitcase, and one (1) personal bag (backpack or purse)**. Make sure the wheels are in good working order if it pulls. It will be 80-95 degrees or more each day and 70's at night.

#### SUGGESTED FOR CHECKED SUITCASE OR CARRY-ON

- Two (2) pairs of shoes, one pair of sneakers or boots for work\* and the other sandals or nicer shoes
- Shower flip flops (not included in the 2 pairs mentioned above)
- Light rain jacket or hoodie
- Clothes for 7 days
  - \_\_\_ Up to four (4) pairs of "scrubs", jeans, or cargo pants for work\*
  - \_\_\_ Up to two (2) pairs of "nicer" jeans or pants (for church and/or the opt. dinner out)
  - \_\_\_ Two to three (2-3) pairs of shorts (preferably Bermuda shorts). You will only wear shorts on your day off and around the ministry center.
  - \_\_\_ Socks & underwear for 9/10 days
  - \_\_\_ Personal items (shampoo, deodorant, soap, toothpaste, etc.)
  - \_\_\_ Seven or more (7+) t-shirts. You will receive one (1) Send Relief shirt.
  - \_\_\_ Church clothes for 1 service (no shorts; skirts should be knee length or below)
  - \_\_\_ Modest sleepwear (dorms have A/C)
- Washcloths and towel
- Set of twin sheets (sheet, fitted, pillowcase)
- Blanket (or sleeping bag)
- Sunglasses (optional)
- Swimsuit (no two-pieces, please)
- Cap/hat
- Travel pillow (optional). Pillows are provided at the ministry center.
- Plastic bag for dirty clothes
- Insect repellent
- Sunscreen



## PUERTO RICO

### What to Bring List

#### SUGGESTED FOR BACKPACK OR PURSE (PERSONAL ITEM)

- Bible
- Notebook/journal
- ID/wallet
- Any medication you are taking (best NOT to pack these in your suitcase)
- Extra contacts or glasses (if needed)
- Cell phone & charger
- Pens
- Earbuds or small headphones for airplane travel
- Any spending money
- Reusable water bottle (empty)
- Snacks (optional) The first meal provided will be dinner, served around 6 pm-6:30 pm.

\*Clothing or shoes you wouldn't mind ruining

#### IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. **Luggage allowance per person:** at the most, two (2) items per person. See below:
  - One (1) suitcase – it can be a checked bag OR carry-on, but do not bring both.
  - One (1) personal bag (backpack or purse).
2. **Contact us beforehand if you are thinking of bringing things to intentionally leave behind, please.** While we appreciate the intention, we may not have room or need for certain things.
3. Contact us beforehand if you have an established long-term partnership with a local church and they request your team to bring special items. We will coordinate with the local church to assist with luggage pick up as our vehicles have limited space.

## Volunteer Guidelines

We desire that every volunteer will have a positive, Christ-centered experience while serving with Send Relief. We want to maintain a safe, healthy, welcoming environment at our Send Relief Event location and on our work sites.

To accomplish this, we have implemented these guidelines:

### 1. Alcohol, Illegal Drugs & Tobacco

---

- We will maintain an Alcohol, Illegal Drugs & Tobacco free environment.

### 2. Students and Minors

---

- Persons between the age of 12-18 are permitted to participate in most Send Relief events. Some events may arise where the minimum age of service is set to 18.
- Anyone between the ages of 12 to 18 must be accompanied by an adult 25 years old or older.
- **Students Ratios (1:5 - 1 adult: 5 students) – Anyone under the age of 21 is considered a student and must be accompanied by an adult 25 years old or older**

### 3. Dress Code

---

- Volunteers will be given a Send Relief T-shirt upon arrival and are asked to wear them when working away from the Event Site.
- You are expected to exemplify Christian values in your clothing and conduct, even when away from the worksite.
- While at the worksite, wear appropriate work clothes, work shoes/boots, and safety equipment as directed by leadership at your site.
- Flip-flops, sandals, or open-toed shoes may not be worn at work sites.
- Volunteers should not wear tight or revealing clothing such as halter tops, bare midriff separates short shorts or clothing with immodest images or wording.
- Volunteers must be fully dressed and wear shoes when leaving the shower trailer and sleeping quarters, and change clothes in bathroom or shower stalls.

### 4. Volunteer Criminal History

---

As an organization, Send Relief believes individuals convicted of criminal acts can be fully restored through the work of Christ in their life. Additionally, we strive to be good stewards of our resources and diligent in our concern for the safety and security of volunteers, homeowners, staff, and resources affiliated with the ministry.

## Volunteer Guidelines

Therefore, volunteer applicants who have been convicted of crimes against minors or sexual offenses are prohibited from volunteering with Send Relief. Other felony convictions involving crimes against persons or crimes that, in the sole discretion of Send Relief, raise concerns about their participation will require a clean record for at least 10 years after conviction or release from prison, whichever is later.

Send Relief reserves the right to restrict or deny volunteer opportunities to any applicant who we reasonably believe may jeopardize the safety and security of volunteers, homeowners, partners, or staff. All overnight volunteers must undergo a Background Check before being permitted to volunteer through Send Relief.

### 5. Health and Disabilities

---

Due to the strenuous activity of disaster response, all participants should carefully evaluate their health and ability to work in harsh, stressful conditions. Individual and group safety is our number one priority. Send Relief retains the right to graciously re-direct or restrict activities. If the health and safety of a volunteer become a concern, the individual or group may be requested to leave the Event Site.

### 6. Animals

---

ADA Service Dogs are welcome, and accommodations will be made for individuals with ADA Service Dogs to participate in Send Relief events. Advance notice must be received in time to implement accommodations. We are unable to accommodate pets or comfort animals that are not ADA certified.
