ABRAHAM, THE "FOUNDER" AND "GREATEST STAR"  
OF THE HEBREW PEOPLE -

ROM 4:11 - THE FATHER OF ALL THEM THAT --  
BELIEVE - FAITH, BEFORE HIS CIRCUMCISION

THE WORLD HAD BEEN JUDGED BY THE FLOOD - - -  
THEN

- LEAD BY NIMROD - SET OUT TO BUILD THE TOWER  
OF BABEL - - -  
IDOLATRY + DEPRAVITY OF MAN  
SET IN AGAIN -

"ABRAHAM"  
"A PILGRIM CHARACTER" -- REPRESENTS  
SEPARATION - (IN THE WORLD - BUT NOT OF  
THE WORLD) -

"SO"

WE HAVE A "PRECIOUS ELEMENT" OF THE  
BELIEVERS LIFE - "A PILGRIM" - OUT OF HIS  
COUNTRY, LAND, CITY + HIS FATHER'S HOUSE,  
"HIS RELATIVES" - (ALL BY SIMPLE FAITH)

## I] AN IMPRESSIVE CALL - 8a

"BY FAITH", ABRAHAM, WHEN HE WAS CALLED<sup>13</sup>

Ⓐ AN IMMEDIATE CALL, OF FAITH -

"THE LORD SAYED TO ABRAHAM: "GO"

ONE MOMENT - A PAGAN MOON WORSHIPPER  
A CITIZEN & ~~REED~~ AMONG "UR" -  
"THEN"

HE WAS A "BELIEVER" & "HEARER" OF  
GOD - HIS "BACK" TOWARD HIS OLD  
LIFE - & HIS "FACE" TOWARD THE  
PROMISE LAND -

A TENT DWELLING PILGRIM -  
LIVING ON DIVINE PROMISES -

"NOT LOOKING BACK"

(AS - SOME BELIEVING HEBREWS WERE)

Ⓑ AN IMPRESSIVE STEP, OF FAITH - 8b

"HE WENT OUT", NOT KNOWING WHITHER  
"HE WENT" -

NO MAP TO GO BY - JUST SIMPLY FAITH  
IN "GOD'S CALL"

- TAKE THE FIRST STEP - THEN - THE NEXT  
WILL BE REVEALED - (THE WHOLE JOURNEY  
STEP BY STEP) <sup>WITH</sup> - NEVER THE WHOLE PICTURE  
"JUST"  
(THE PROMISE - & GOD'S FAITHFULNESS)

THE CHRISTIAN IS JOURNEYING ON TO A CITY THAT  
HATH FOUNDATION IN GOD -- (WE HAVE COME OUT OF  
THE WORLD -- BECAUSE JESUS SAID:)

"YE ARE NOT OF THE WORLD," EVEN AS I AM NOT  
OF THE WORLD"

## II] A STRANGE COUNTRY - ⑨

"BY FAITH" ABRAHAM JOURNEYED IN THE LAND  
PROMISED - BY FAITH - A STRANGE COUNTRY -

HE FOUND THIS COUNTRY OCCUPIED BY A  
"FOUL & DEGRADED RACE"

"HE"  
DID NOT ATTEMPT TO ACQUIRE LAND HIMSELF -  
HE, BY FAITH -  
LIVED AS A PILGRIM - "KNOWING GOD"  
HAD CALLED & PROMISED -

ROUND ABOUT HIM WERE WALLED CITIES -  
- YET -- THE LAND BELONGED TO HIM BY  
PROMISE -- "HE DWELLED IN TENTS" ⑩

A) AS A PARTNER WITH GOD'S PEOPLE - ⑪  
- WITH "ISSAC" & "JACOB" -

THE PROMISE WAS TO ABRAHAM & HIS SEED -  
SO "ABRAHAM WAITED" - DWELLING WITH  
HIS SON & GRANDSON -

(FELLOWSHIP WITH FELLOW BELIEVERS)

⑧ A PARTAKER OF GOD'S PROMISES → 9c 10  
"HEIRS WITH HIM"  
(DWELLING & BELIEVING)

"LOOKING"  
FOR THE "CITY OF GOD" → 10  
"BUILT & MADE BY GOD" -- HE LOOKED =

MEANS = EAGERLY EXPECTED -  
ABRAHAM REALIZED -- GOD'S PROMISES  
WERE FOR A HEAVENLY COUNTRY - IN  
"THE COMING AGE" - HEAVEN'S SPIRITUAL  
(Rev 21:19-20) REALITIES

### III AN IMPOSSIBLE CONDITION - 11-16

"EVEN SARAH" (BY FAITH)

ALWAYS ADMIREABLE -- IN SUBJECTION TO  
ABRAHAM -- QUEENLINESS IN GOD'S SIGHT --

"PETER" COMMENDED HER "AS SARAH  
OBEDIED ABRAHAM, CALLING HIM LORD"

① SELF-SACRIFICING = THE STORE OF HAGAR &  
"ISHMAEL"

② A NEW REVELATION = AFTER "13 yrs" NEW NAMES  
AND "A SON"

From Hagar to  
"ISHMAEL"

(A) SARAH - (10)  
- WHEN SHE WAS "PAST AGE" -  
"DELIVERED A SON" - (BY ABRAHAM)  
"BECAUSE"  
(SHE JUDGED HIM FAITHFUL THAT PROMISED)

(B) ABRAHAM - (12)  
"AS GOOD AS DEAD"  
100 yrs OLD - "PAST THE AGE"  
"THE DEARNESS BRINGS ALL GLORY TO GOD"  
AND PROMISE:  
"HIS DESCENDENTS": "AS THE STARS" &  
"AS THE SAND"  
(THEY COUNTED GOD FAITHFUL)

(C) THREE GENERATION - (13-16) (ABRAHAM, ISAAC, JACOB)  
PASSED - "NOT SEEING THE PROMISES"  
THE PROMISED SON - "YES" - BUT WHAT  
ABOUT - THE PROMISED LAND - (13a)

① THEIR BOLD ASSURANCE - (13)  
"THEY SAW AFAR OFF & WERE  
PERSUADED & EMBRACED THEM -  
&  
CONFESSED STRANGERS & PILGRIMS -

② THEIR BELIVING ATTITUDE - 14-15

ABOVE & BEYOND "THE EARTHLY PROMISE" -  
THEY "SEEK A COUNTRY" -

THANK GOD FOR CANAAN - "BUT" PRAISE  
GOD - THERE IS HEAVEN -

VS 15 THERE WAS NO OPPORTUNITY TO  
RETURN - (TO THE OLD) FOR  
- FAITH WILL NOT ALLOW IT -

THIS BROUGHT A:

③ BLESSED ACHIEVEMENT - 16

④ GOD IS NOT ASHAMED OF THEM -  
- I AM THE GOD OF ABRAHAM, ISSAC,  
JACOB - <sup>"WHAT A DISTINCTION"</sup>

⑤ GOD HAS PREPARED FOR THEM A CITY -  
PREPARED - <sup>"ALREADY BEEN DONE"</sup>

⑥ THEY DESERVED A BETTER COUNTRY -  
(THAN CANAAN) -

## IV] AN IMPOSSIBLE COMMAND - (17-18)

- ① TRIALS COME IN THE PATHWAY OF FAITH &
- ② TRIALS OFTEN TOUCHES OUR AFFECTIONS —

### (A) THE MAGNITUDE OF THE TEST - (17)

- OFFER UP ISSAC - HIS ONLY BEGOTTEN SON -

- (ABRAHAM WENT THROUGH WITH IT) -

→ HE TRUSTED GOD WAS ABLE TO RAISE ISSAC UP AGAIN & RECEIVING HIM BACK —

### (C) THE MEANING BEHIND THE TRIAL - (19)

"HE RECEIVED HIM IN A FIGURE"

HE TOOK INTO ACCOUNT "FIGURES" →

GOD COULD DO THE IMPOSSIBLE → "SO"

ABRAHAM DID THE IMPOSSIBLE →

BY FAITH IT'S
